* Issue with creating slips from within Outlook.

** Small issue with generating log files during transaction transfer (log file is only needed for troubleshooting)

*** Based on communication with Microsoft if no issues were found in the 64bit environment then it is safe to assume the 32bit environment would be issue free as well

Testing in a multiple operating system network environment was also performed and no issues found.
